Spin the Wheel was by far the favorite Midway Game they played.

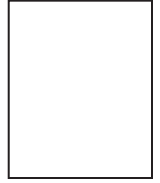


Myrt and Elvera choose from the table of donated prizes for their win at the games!

Elvera will be celebrating her 100th birthday this November here at Northshire



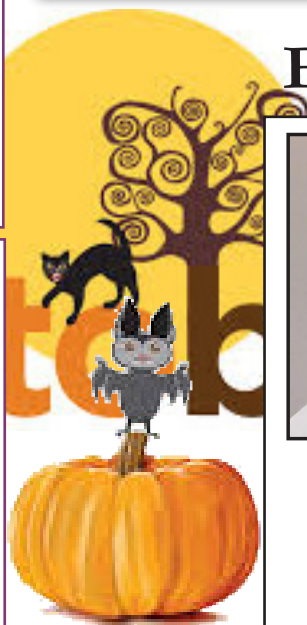

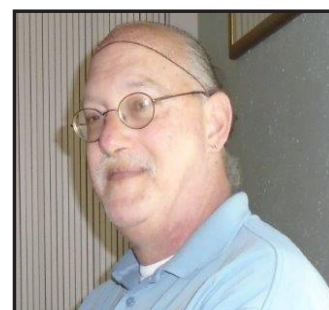

Myrt and Vi show off their finished coasters.



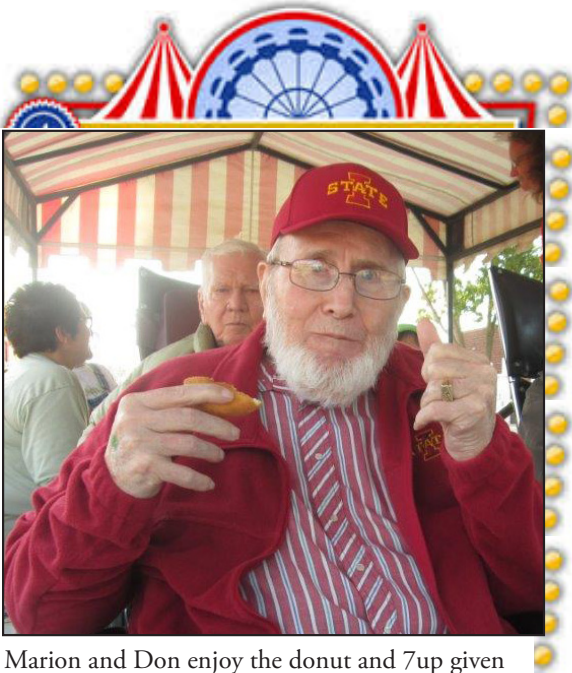
The Wii has become a popular game for some of the folks here. They can bowl with a partner or alone or as a group.
