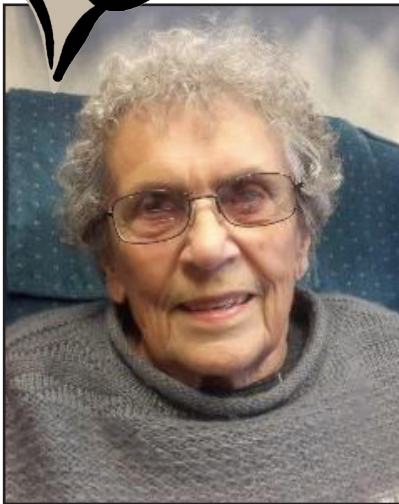




## Resident Spotlight

## Meals with Residents Update

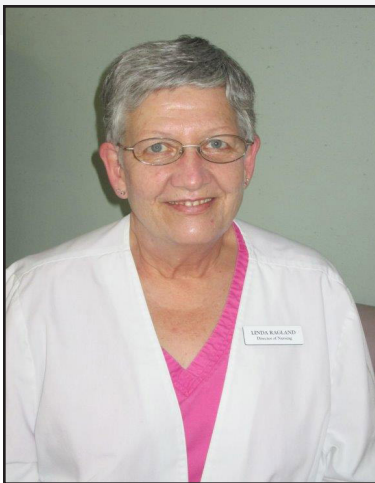

I love to garden and enjoy reading.

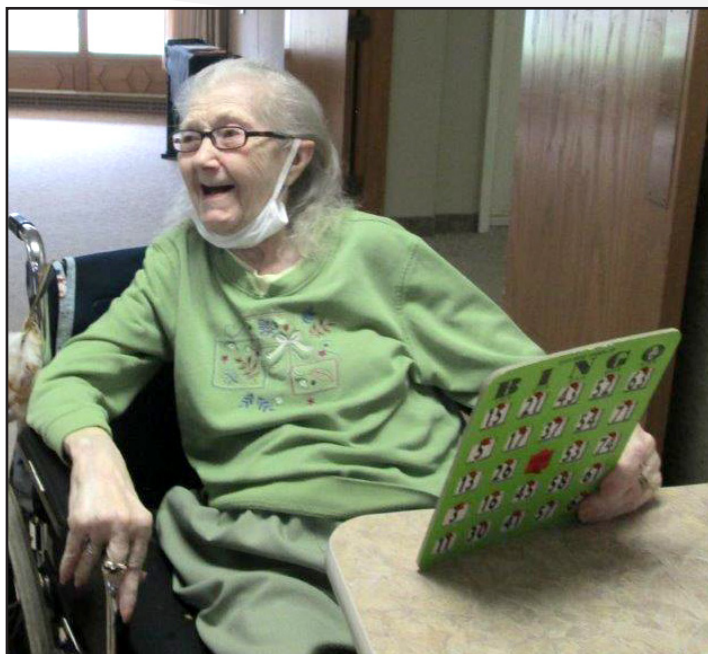

Phyllis, Sara, Sue and Joe are glad to be out of their rooms to play bingo with friends again!



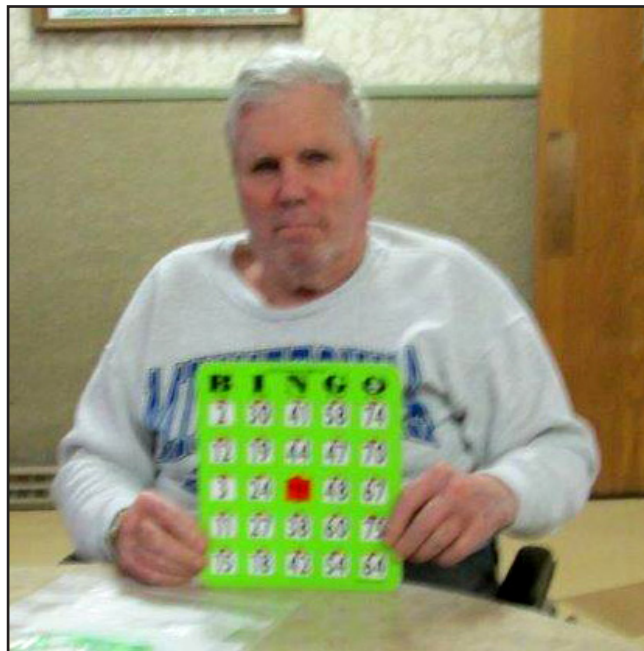

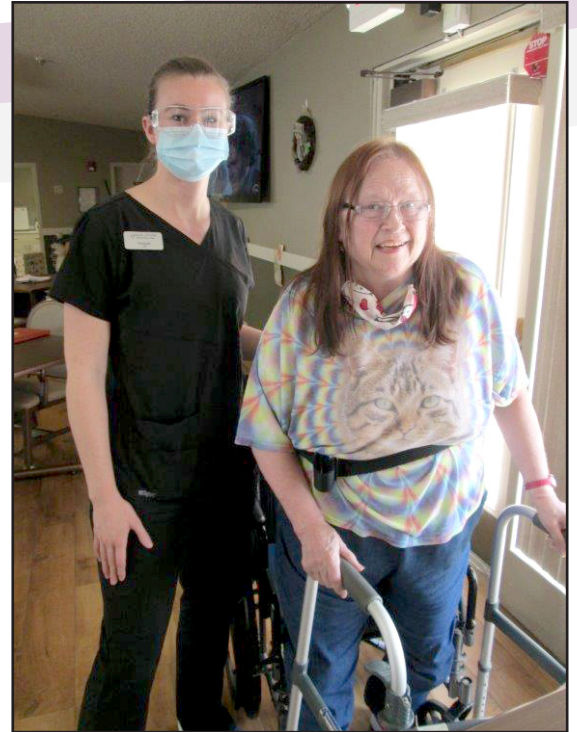

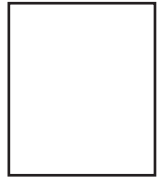
